A bold design for Nottingham Girls' High School

Affinity2⁵⁵ PUR heavy commercial luxury vinyl tiles were used to create a simple yet stunning floor design for a refurbished common room area at Nottingham Girls' High School.

The contrasting Champagne Oak and Jet Black Ash wood effect designs from the Affinity2⁵⁵ LVT collection were installed by local flooring contractors **Slack & Co Floorcoverings Ltd** at the independent school for girls near Nottingham city centre. A large square was created using the Jet Black Ash shade in the centre of the floor to contrast against the common room's white furniture.

Helping to refurbish Beechwood cancer care centre

Expona Flow flooring adds vibrant touch to the University of Nottingham

Heavy commercial **Expona Flow PUR** sheet vinyl flooring was installed in the School of Life Sciences building at the **University of Nottingham** to help create a striking break out area for students to relax, work and grab a snack in between lectures.

Around 300m² of Expona Flow high design vinyl flooring was installed by local flooring contractor **Derbyshire Floorcraft Ltd** in the Life Sciences building's vending machine lounge. The bold and graphic Firelight design was chosen from the Infinity collection within the Expona Flow product range by main contractor Petric Contracts.

This abstract design gives the effect of endless wood, featuring contrasting warm orange and cool blue tones in a linear design which perfectly complement the newly refurbished lounge's dark blue walls and orange furniture.

A geometric floor design for Solihull School sixth formers


A combination of high performance flooring from Polyflor's luxury vinyl tile and sheet vinyl flooring ranges was used to create a dynamic, geometric flooring design at **Solihull School's brand new Sixth Form centre**.

Installed by Tamworth based **Gladston Contract Flooring Specialists**,

Pearlazzo PUR homogeneous sheet flooring was used to produce a hexagonal patterned floor design in the centre's breakout and dining area whilst Expona Control PUR luxury vinyl tiles created a pathway through the common room area and into the adjoining corridors and staircases. The £4.5m new build project at the independent school in the West Midlands was managed by main contractor Speller Metcalfe and designed by Birmingham based architects Malcolm Payne Design Group.

Four shades from the popular **Pearlazzo PUR** collection (Mineral, Rain Cloud, Charcoal and Sunrise) were selected to create the geometric flooring design, with hexagon shapes created by Polyflor's in-house Design Service using precision waterjet cutting technology. **Expona Control PUR** luxury vinyl tiles in Light Elm were installed in circulation areas to offer sustainable wet slip resistance where slippages are more likely to occur.

Sean Morgan, Senior Deputy Headmaster at Solihull School commented, "For our state of the art Sixth Form facilities we wanted to create a bright, modern space that will motivate our students. Polyflor flooring fitted our needs perfectly, being both practical and visually appealing."


Expona adds beauty to skincare brand's flagship store




The warm tones in Amber Classic Oak from the Expona Design collection perfectly the signature pink and orange colours which represents the global doughnut and coffeehouse chain.
